

PRAYER GUIDE

Week of January 26-February 1

EVERY DAY--Pray for an end to the drought in Central Texas and for all people everywhere who suffer from lack of access to clean water. Pray for those on our prayer list. Please remember to thank God daily for the gifts with which he has blessed us and for God's unwavering love. **PRAY THAT OUR WORSHIP AND FELLOWSHIP DINNER ON SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 1, WILL BE WELL-ATTENDED.**

MONDAY, JAN. 26--Read Deuteronomy 18:15-20. Pray for the grace and insight to listen to the words of Jesus. Pray that we may see and hear Jesus in our time of devotion and in our daily living. Pray for those who do not yet know Jesus, that faithful disciples will bear witness to them.

TUESDAY, JAN. 27--Read Deuteronomy 18:15-20. Pray that each of us as individuals and that we as a congregation will witness to the love of God in our words and our deeds.

WEDNESDAY, JAN. 28--Read Psalm 111. Ask God to give you and the leaders of our congregation God's wisdom. Ask for the faith to accept and to follow God's wisdom.

THURSDAY, JAN. 29--Read 1 Corinthians 8:1-13. Ask God to reveal where there is division and disharmony within the church which threatens our witness to God's love and presence. Ask God to help each of us become an instrument of healing any rifts that are present.

FRIDAY, JAN. 30--Read 1 Corinthians 8:1-13. Ask God to enable us to be good examples of faithful living to each other, especially those who might not be mature in their faith, and to others who might not yet know Christ.

SATURDAY, JAN. 31--Read Mark 1:21-28. Pray for individuals you know and for all those who are struggling with various demons in their lives, whether they are addictions, depression, anger, feelings of unworthiness, or however their lives may be being afflicted. Pray that they may be healed by the power of Jesus.

SUNDAY, FEB. 1--Read Mark 1:21-28. Pray that God may touch the hearts of those who attend worship today and bring them closer to God. Pray that our worship and fellowship dinner which we share may draw us closer to God, closer to each other, and deeper into faithful ministry.
